## Full Professor in Diagnostic Imaging according to §98 UG 2002

### **Responsibilities:**

The University of Veterinary Medicine Vienna is a dynamic campus, offering a multitude of opportunities for development. In the past international evaluation of teaching and research, our university received a very positive rating.

The responsibilities of the future job occupant include research, teaching, clinical services, and postgraduate education in all fields of Diagnostic Imaging, such as radiology, ultrasonography, computed tomography, magnetic resonance imaging, and scintigraphy. The development of Diagnostic Imaging at a high quality level is guaranteed by the use of equipment with the latest technology.

Diagnostic Imaging is a central, integrated field within the teaching hospital. Diagnostic services are provided for all animal species; an interest in oncology is favorable. The candidate should be recognized internationally in clinics and research and is expected to establish a Residency Teaching Program in conjunction with the European College of Veterinary Diagnostic Imaging (ECVDI).

The successful candidate will coordinate and take on the education in the Diploma program in veterinary medicine, as well as the specialization programs and all further study courses at the Vetmeduni Vienna.

### **Qualifications:**

- a) Diplomate of the European College of Veterinary Diagnostic Imaging (ECVDI) or American College of Veterinary Radiology (ACVR)
- b) Habilitation or equivalent qualification
- c) management skills as well as strong leadership qualities
- d) proof of collaboration in international research and recruitment of funds
- e) teaching experience and qualifications

### **Preferences:**

- a) experience in Diagnostic Imaging from abroad
- b) experience in teaching residents
- c) candidates from non-German speaking countries are expected – in case of an appointment – to learn German within a reasonable time frame.

### **Minimum wages:**

The University Professor will be employed in a permanent position and is classified as group A1 in the collective contract for university employees. Overpayment of the monthly minimum wage in the collective contract (€ 4697.80) can be discussed during the appointment hearings.

The Vetmeduni Vienna is striving to advance the proportion of women in their faculty, especially in leading positions and a balance in the number of women and men working at the university according to § 41 UG 2002, especially with scientific personnel. Qualified women are therefore urged to apply. Should women be under-represented (less than 50%), female candidates with qualifications equal to the most qualified man will be given precedence, should there be no reasons outweighing his application.

Written applications should be submitted in English with the usual documents (letter of motivation, curriculum vitae, publication list, summary of previous research and teaching experience, description of previous experience in organization, management and leadership roles, and 3 publications viewed as most outstanding by the applicant) by January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015.
