

JUNE EXAM SESSION 2026 FOR ALL STUDENTS

- **The June examination session 2026 for all students will take place from 19 June to 30 June 2026.**
- **Students enrolled in the Integrated Academic Studies Programme may register for examinations online from 12 June to 16 June 2026, at any time of day.**
- **Funds for examination registration fees and the third tuition installment (for those who have not yet paid it) must be paid by 12 June 2026.**
- **The electronic allocation of examiners will be conducted on 17 June 2026, at approximately 1:00 p.m.**
- **Late examination registration will be possible from 17 June 2026 through the Student Affairs Office for students in English. However, after the examiner allocation process has been completed at 1:00 p.m., students must obtain written approval from the Head of Department or the course instructor in order to register for an examination subsequently. The approval form may be obtained from the Student Affairs Office. All late examination registrations will be charged according to the valid price list of services.**
- **Confirmation of examination attendance is mandatory and must be completed exclusively through student FIS accounts on 18 June 2026 (Thursday).**
- **Permission for students who have not confirmed their examination attendance to take the examination falls exclusively within the authority of the course instructor to whom the student has been assigned through the electronic examiner allocation process. The Student Affairs Office has no technical means to perform subsequent confirmation of examination attendance and is not authorized to grant such approvals. If the instructor allows a student who has not confirmed attendance to sit the examination, there are no restrictions on entering into FIS any grade obtained by that student.**
- **The examination schedule and all other obligations related to the examination session should be checked on the Faculty website and with the relevant departments.**

JULY EXAM SESSION 2026 FOR ALL STUDENTS

The July examination session 2026 for all students will take place from 10 July to 20 July 2026.

- **Students enrolled in the Integrated Academic Studies Programme may register for examinations online from 4 July to 6 July 2026, at any time of day.**
- **Funds for examination registration fees and the third tuition installment (for those who have not yet paid it) must be available in student accounts by 4 July 2026. Since the examination registration period for the July session begins on a Saturday, students are advised to make payments several days in advance to allow sufficient time for the funds to be credited to their accounts.**
- **The electronic allocation of examiners will be conducted on 7 July 2026, at approximately 1:00 p.m.**
- **Late examination registration will be possible from 7 July 2026 through the Student Affairs Office for studies in English. However, after the examiner allocation process has been completed at 1:00 p.m., students must obtain written approval from the Head of Department or the course instructor in order to register for an examination subsequently. The approval form may be obtained from the Student Affairs Office. All late examination registrations will be charged according to the valid price list of services.**
- **Confirmation of examination attendance is mandatory and must be completed exclusively through student FIS accounts on 8 and 9 July 2026 (Wednesday and Thursday).**
- **Permission for students who have not confirmed their examination attendance to take the examination falls exclusively within the authority of the course instructor to whom the student has been assigned through the electronic examiner allocation process. The Student Affairs Office has no technical means to perform subsequent confirmation of examination attendance and is not authorized to grant such approvals.
